<b>Universal Supports – Tools for All Students</b>			
<b>Highlighter</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This tool can be used to highlight some test content. Students can also remove highlights one-by-one or by using the clear-all option.</li> </ul>	<b>Highlighters</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Highlight</b> on any doc, webpage and most PDFs using the available colors of yellow, blue, green, and pink.</li> <li><b>Collect highlights by color</b> and export them into a Google document with citation information.</li> </ul>
<b>Line Guide</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Movable, straightedge line used to follow along with each line of text. Students can drag the guide up or down on the screen as an aid in reading an item or passage.</li> </ul>	<b>Screen Masking</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tints your screen</b> and <b>provides a reading light</b> that follows your mouse pointer, <b>to help improve focus.</b></li> <li><b>Can also be used as a line</b> by changing the reading light to a color and turning off the background color.</li> </ul>
<b>Sticky Notes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Creates and places a note on the screen in which a student can type a short message for later reference. Multiple notes can be created for each item or passage, and the notes can be moved around the screen, minimized or completely hidden, and re-opened.</li> </ul>	<b>Pushpin Annotations</b>  <b>PDF Comments</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Pushpins allow you to insert notes</b>, ideas or questions on your PDF. Leaves a red pushpin icon wherever the annotation was made.</li> <li><b>PDF Comments</b> allows you to comment on a PDF the same way you can do so on a Google doc.</li> </ul>
<b>Designated Supports - Tools for Students with Disabilities and ELL</b>			
<b>Stacked Translations (Spanish)</b>  <b>Word-to-Word Bilingual Dictionary</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stacked Spanish translations are available as a language support to designated students on all mathematics, science, and social studies assessments. For ELA assessments, only the test directions are available in stacked translation.</li> <li>A Word -to-Word Bilingual Dictionary may be provided as a designated language support.</li> </ul>	<b>Translator</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Allows single words to be translated</b> into 60+ languages. Translations for Spanish can be speech-enabled.</li> </ul>

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<b>Designated Supports - Tools for Students with Disabilities and ELL</b>			
<p><b>Masking</b></p> <p><b>Color Overlay</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows the student to cover up (mask) content that may be distracting, enabling the student to more easily focus their attention on a specific part of the screen.</li> <li>A transparent colored sheet that is placed over a page of text or is affixed to a computer screen.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Screen Masking</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tints your screen</b> and <b>provides a reading light</b> that follows your mouse pointer, <b>to help improve focus.</b></li> <li><b>Can also be used as a color overlay</b> by turning off the reading light and adjusting the background color needed to be overlay.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Text-to-Speech (Computer Voice)</b> (Not for reading passages)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The text -to-speech (TTS) function allows the student to listen via headphones or speakers to test information displayed on the screen. Words and numbers, test directions, questions, answer choices, and other information is read aloud by the computer and may be replayed as necessary.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Text to Speech</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Read text aloud</b> with dual color highlighting using natural sounding male and female voices. International voices available for speech-enabling other languages including Spanish.</li> </ul>
